We are writing to inform you of an important change to your expiring Resilium Motor Fleet Policy Product Disclosure Statement R00034 17/11/12A.

General Insurance Transfer

On and from 1 July 2013, GIO General Limited transferred its general insurance business to a related company, AAI Limited ABN 48 005 297 807 (**AAI**) by way of a scheme under the *Insurance Act 1973* (Cth) which was confirmed by the Federal Court of Australia. The scheme was one of four schemes which occurred simultaneously as part of an internal reorganisation.

In the months before the Court confirmed the scheme, GIO General Limited undertook steps (including but not limited to newspaper and internet advertising) to bring the then proposed transfer to the attention of policyholders.

On and from 1 July 2013:

- AAI became the underwriter of all general insurance policies issued by GIO General Limited and will settle all claims under those policies;
- AAI has issued and will continue to issue Resilium branded general insurance policies and will trade under the business name 'GIO'; and
- all references to GIO General Limited ABN 22 002 861 583 (however that company may be referred to) in your policy documents (including your policy schedule or certificate), changed to become a reference to AAI Limited ABN 48 005 297 807 trading as GIO.

All policies issued / contracts of insurance entered into:

- **before 1 July 2013** were issued by and entered into with GIO General Limited and were transferred to AAI on 1 July 2013; and
- **on or after 1 July 2013** were and continue to be issued by and entered into with AAI.

Your expiring policy is unchanged except as indicated above.
